



North Wales Police saves £1m by using Blackberrys

NORTH Wales Police claims its decision to equip police with BlackBerrys (wireless e-mail devices) has saved the force around £1m.

More than 1,000 officers in North Wales are now using the handheld devices which allow officers to access the force's computer system remotely while on the street.

This has increased officer visibility and productivity leading to efficiencies valued at more than £1m over three years.

The force and Niche Technology have now been shortlisted for the National Business Awards, in the Best Use of Technology in Business category.
